2019 County & Township Road Projects

1. 2019 Countywide Pavement Resurfacing

May to October 2019 Investment - \$8 million
Asphalt resurfacing, micro-surfacing, chip sealing, crack sealing, berm repair, pavement marking and other work on various county and township roads.

2. South Old 3C Highway Improvements

June 2018 to November 2019 Investment - \$5.5 million
Reconstruction from north of Mt. Royal Ave. to north of
Freeman Road including storm sewers, curbs, gutters,
sidewalks and a new traffic signal at Hawksbeard/Genoa
Middle School. Northbound traffic will be detoured beginning spring 2019. Southbound-only traffic will be maintained for work zone residents.

3. Piatt Road Extension (Cheshire to Berlin Station)

July 2018 to August 2019 Investment - \$3.3 million
New road from Cheshire Road to Olentangy Berlin High
School. New single-lane modern roundabout at Cheshire
Road beginning June 2019 with 2-month intersection closure. Road work complete by mid-August.

4. S.R. 315 & Home Road Intersection

June to December 2019 Investment - \$5.3 million

New traffic signal and widening of Home Road to 5 lanes
east and west of SR 315. 5-month closure for reconstruction of the bridge beginning July 2019. SR 315 intersection
and Home Road west will remain open during bridge
construction with short-term closures in late 2019.

5. Steitz Road Extension North of Hyatts Road

April to September 2019 Investment - \$2.1 million Extension of Steitz Road north of Hyatts Road and construction of a single-lane modern roundabout at Hyatts Road. 2-month intersection closure beginning in June.

6. Lewis Center & North Road Improvements

April to October 2019 Investment - \$3.5 million
New single-lane modern roundabout at Lewis Center &
North Road and minor widening of both roads. North
Road closed for 2 months beginning in April. Intersection
closed for 2 months beginning in June. Lewis Center
closed west of North Road for 2 months beginning in August. Completion October 2019.

7. County Home, Plumb and Bunty Station CulvertsApril to Oct 2019 Investment - \$400,000

Replacement of 3 large culverts—first on County Home Road 1/2 mile west of SR 521; second on Plumb Road 1/2 mile west of I-71; third on Bunty Station 1/4 mile east of Section Line. 6-week road closure for each culvert with posted detours.

8. Worthington & Freeman Road Intersection

June to August 2019 Investment - \$700,000

New traffic signal with realignment of Freeman Road and minor widening of Worthington Road. 2-month closure of Freeman Road with short-term closures and lane restrictions on Worthington Road and Olympic Way.

9. Highfield & Green Meadows Drive Intersection

July to October 2019 Investment - \$1 million

New single-lane modern roundabout at Highfield & Green

Meadows Drive. 2-month intersection closure.

10. Centerburg Road over Culver Creek Bridge Rehab

August to November 2019 Investment - \$280,000 Bridge deck replacement of the structure just west of Fredricks Road. 2-month closure with posted detour.

11. Home Road Extension East of US 23

August 2019 to Sept. 2020 Investment - \$8 million
New 0.8 mile long, 4-lane roadway east of US 23 ending just
west of the NS/CSX railroad including extension of Graphics
Way and Green Meadows Drive north to the new Home
Road. Addition of turn lanes on US 23 with traffic maintained
except for short-term lane restrictions.

12. Harlem/Woodtown Road Improvements

September to December 2019 Investment - \$1 million Replacement of a bridge on Harlem Road 1/8 mile west of Woodtown Road with minor widening and shoulder improvements at the intersection. 3-month closure of Harlem Road west of Woodtown Road.

13. Liberty & Seldom Seen Road Intersection

Sept. 2019 to June 2020 Investment - \$1 million

New traffic signal and left turn lanes on Liberty Road. Traffic maintained except for short-term lane restrictions.

14. East Powell Road Improvements, Phase 2

Oct. 2019 to May 2021 Investment - \$9 million
Reconstruction from South Old State Road to Bale Kenyon
Road including widening to 3 lanes, constructing storm sewers, curbs and gutters and new traffic signals at Tahoma
Street, Coldharbor Drive and Walker Woods Blvd. Road
work will go from east to west beginning with storm sewer
work late 2019 between I-71 and Bale Kenyon. Segments of
Powell Road will be closed beginning late 2019 or 2020.

15. New Traffic Signals

Nov. 2019 to April 2020 Investment - \$800,000 New traffic signals on Old State Road at Parklawn Drive (north and south), Alum Crossing and Bear Trail; and, on Lewis Center Road at Rail Timber Way.

2020-21 Projects

A. 2020 Countywide Pavement Resurfacing

Summer/Fall 2020 Investment - \$8 million

Asphalt resurfacing, micro-surfacing, chip sealing, crack sealing, berm repair, pavement marking and other work on various county and township roads.

B. US 23 & Hyatts Road Intersection

Spring/Summer 2020 Investment - \$2.4 million
Widening of Hyatts Road and Shanahan Road for left
turn lanes at US 23.

C. Orange Road Improvements, Phase 2

Spring to Fall 2020 Investment - \$3.0 million
Widening of Orange Road to 5 lanes from the U.S. Post
Office to just east of Green Meadows Drive and 4 new
traffic signals at North Central, Highfield, Green Meadows and Blue Holly Drive.

D. Cheshire and Old State Intersection

Summer 2020 Investment - \$1.4 million New single-lane modern roundabout.

E. Africa and Cheshire Road Widening

Summer/Fall 2020 Investment - \$2.5 million

Minor widening for paved shoulders on Cheshire Road causeway over Alum Creek Lake and on Africa Road from Jaycox to Cheshire Road. Also, new turn lanes on Africa Road at Lewis Center (east) and at Plumb Road.

F. Worthington & Africa Road Intersection

Summer 2020 to Fall 2021 Investment - \$5.8 million

Widening of Worthington Road to 5 lanes through the Africa Road intersection and 3 lanes between Africa and Highland Lakes Avenue. New right turn lane on southbound Africa Road.

G. Home Road Improvements (Perry Road to US 23)


Fall 2020 to Fall 2021 Investment - \$3.2 million
Widening of Home Road from Perry Road to 1/4 mile
west of US 23 for a center turn lane.

H. Home Road and SR 745 (Dublin Road) Intersection

Summer/Fall 2021 Investment - \$2.2 million
New single-lane modern roundabout.

I. Liberty Road and Salisbury Drive Intersection

Summer/Fall 2021 Investment - \$1.2 million New single-lane modern roundabout.
