Berlin Station Road Improvements – DEL-CR91-1.85

Phase 1A

Project Description:

In Phase 1A of the project, the Delaware County Engineer's Office (DCEO) will widen Berlin Station Road from the intersection with Braumiller Road to the limits of the recently completed Glenn Parkway extension project by the City of Delaware. Additionally, on the south leg of the intersection, Braumiller Road will be improved by flattening the sag in the road and replacing the existing culvert.

Project Need:

Delaware County is experiencing residential growth in the area southeast of the City of Delaware, and projections show increased traffic volumes along the Berlin Station Road corridor. The Phase 1A improvements will improve safety of both Berlin Station and Braumiller Roads. The new structure ensures a safe crossing over Weiser Run meeting the long-term needs of the area.

Project Limits:

The proposed improvements to the east leg of Berlin Station Road will extend from the west side of the Braumiller Road intersection and extend 2200 feet east to the limits of the recently completed Glenn Parkway extension. Improvements to the south leg of Braumiller Road will begin approximately 600' south of and will extend just thru the Berlin Station Road intersection.

Project Details:

- Widens both roadways to standard lane width of 11 feet
- Replaces existing 9.3'x5.4' concrete box culvert over Weiser Run
- Will accommodate future roundabout to reduce future property impacts on south and east legs.

Proposed Project Schedule & Potential Closures:

Design and Engineering:	2019 to 2021
Right-of-Way Acquisition:	2021 to 2022
Construction:	Summer/Fall 2022

On Berlin Station Road, one lane of traffic will be maintained in the eastbound direction for the duration of the project. It is anticipated that the south leg of Braumiller Road will be closed for about 2 months during summer of 2022. Please note the above dates are approximate and are subject to change as the project progresses. Public notification of closures will be given through the DCEO.

Estimated Project Cost:

The current cost of construction is approximately \$1.91 million dollars. Funding is through the DCEO.
