Berlin Station Road Improvements – DEL-CR91-1.85

Phase 1B

Project Description:

In Phase 1B of the project, the Delaware County Engineer's Office (DCEO) is planning to upgrade the intersection of Berlin Station Road & Braumiller Road with a single-lane modern roundabout.

Project Need:

Delaware County is experiencing residential growth in the area southeast of the City of Delaware. Development planned in the next 5-10 years in the project area will trigger the need for traffic flow improvements at the Berlin Station Road & Braumiller Road intersection.

Project Limits:

The proposed project improvements to will extend:

- South leg (Braumiller Road) – approximately 500 feet south of existing intersection
- West leg (Braumiller Road) – approximately 450 feet west of existing intersection
- North leg (Berlin Station Road) – approximately 500 feet north of existing intersection
- East leg (Berlin Station Road) – approximately 450 feet west of existing intersection

Project Details:

- Constructs a modern, single lane roundabout at the intersection of Berlin Station Road and Braumiller Road

Proposed Project Schedule & Potential Closures:

Design and Engineering:	2019 to 2021
Right-of-Way Acquisition:	TBD (2025-27)
Construction:	TBD (2027 or later)

The intersection is expected to close for about 2 months to build the roundabout. Public notification of closures will be given through the DCEO.

Estimated Project Cost:

The cost of construction is estimated at approximately \$1.3 million dollars.
