2017 DELAWARE COUNTY ROAD & BRIDGE PROJECTS

1. Countywide Pavement Resurfacing Program (not mapped)

Schedule: May to October 2017 Investment: \$7 million Asphalt resurfacing, micro-surfacing, chip sealing, crack sealing, berm repair, pavement marking and other work on various county and township roads.

2. Sawmill Parkway Extension, Phases F

Schedule: July 2015 to July 2017 Investment: \$30 million Completion of work at US 42 and Sawmill Parkway including turn lanes and culvert replacement under US 42. Two-way traffic will be maintained with temporary lane restrictions from April to July.

3. East Powell Road Improvements, Phase 1

Schedule: July 2016 to June 2017 Investment: \$1.7 million Complete remaining work at East Powell Road and Bale Kenyon Road including widening to 3 lanes and installing traffic signal. Powell Road will be closed west of Bale Kenyon beginning in April for about 7 weeks.

4. Sunbury Road Improvements (County Line to Maxtown Rd.)

Schedule: Nov. 2016 to Nov. 2017 Investment: \$4.3 million Reconstruction and widening of Sunbury Road from County Line Road to Maxtown Road. Southbound traffic will be detoured at Maxtown beginning in June for about 5 months. Northbound traffic will be maintained through the work zone.

5. Hogback Road Bridge Replacement

Schedule: Feb. to April 2017 Investment: \$120,000 Bridge replacement on Hogback Road 1/2 mile south of SR 521. 2-month road closure.

6. South Section Line Road Culvert Replacement

Schedule: March to April 2017 Investment: \$60,000 Culvert replacement on Section Line Road 1/4 mile south of Bunty Station Road. 3-week road closure.

7. Warren Road Culvert Replacement

Schedule: April to May 2017 Investment: \$80,000 Culvert replacement on Warren Road 1/2 mile north of US 36 (Scioto Township). 6-week road closure.

8. Perfect Road Bridge Rehabilitation

Schedule: April to June 2017 Investment: \$250,000 Bridge rehabilitation on Perfect Road located just north of Old 3C Highway. 6-week road closure.

9. Fredricks Road Bridge Rehabilitation

Schedule: April to June 2017 Investment: \$250,000 Bridge rehabilitation on Fredricks Road located about 1 mile south of Olive Green Road. 6-week road closure.

10. Gorsuch Road Culvert Replacement

Schedule: May to July 2017 Investment: \$100,000 Culvert replacement on Gorsuch Road located east of Harlem Road (Harlem Township). 2-month road closure.

11. Lewis Center & Bale Kenvon Improvements

Schedule: May to Nov. 2017

Investment: \$4.5 million Construction of a modern roundabout at Lewis Center and Bale Kenyon Road, replacement of the deck on the bridge over Alum Creek, widening of Bale Kenyon and construction of a bike path. Lewis Center Road will be closed east of Bale Kenyon beginning in May for 2 months, followed by a full closure of the intersection in July for an additional 1 month. Lewis Center will reopen in August. Northbound traffic on Bale Kenyon will be detoured (southbound will be maintained) for 2 months beginning in May. In August, Bale Kenyon will be closed to through traffic for 3 months. Access to Bale Kenyon Bluffs will be maintained from the north for 6 weeks, then from the south for the remainder of the closure. Access to River's Edge subdivision will be from the south between August and November.

12. South Old State Road Improvements, Phase 1

Schedule: June 2017 to Oct. 2018 Investment: \$15 million Reconstruction and widening of South Old State Road from Wynstone Drive to Abbey Knoll Drive. 4-lane section with shared use path and sidewalk and new turn lanes at Polaris Pkwy. Two-way traffic maintained during construction on Old State with short term side road closures.

13. Worthington and Big Walnut Road Intersection

Schedule: June to Nov. 2017 Investment: \$2.4 million Construction of turn lanes and a traffic signal at the intersection. The north and east legs of the intersection will close together in June for 3 months while traffic is maintained on the other legs. In September, the south and west legs of the intersection will close for 2 months while traffic is maintained on the other legs.

14. Moody Road Bridges over Sage Creek

Schedule: July to Oct. 2017 Investment: \$100,000 Replacement of 2 bridges on Moody Road north of SR 521. 6-week road closure for each bridge.

15. South Old 3C Highway Improvements, Phase 1

Schedule: Aug. 2017 to Nov. 2018 Investment: \$6 million Reconstruction of South Old 3C Highway from Mt. Royal Ave. to Freeman Road including storm sewers, curbs and gutters and a traffic signal at Hawksbeard Drive. South Old 3C will be closed to through traffic between Hawksbeard Drive and Mt. Royal Ave. beginning September 2017 with southbound traffic maintained to local residences.

16. Liberty and Jewett Road Intersection

Schedule: Sep. to Dec. 2017 Investment: \$1.3 million Construction of a single-lane modern roundabout and extension of a shared use path along Liberty Road connecting Torrington Drive to Murphy Parkway. Intersection closed for 3 months beginning in September.

17. Worthington Road and Highland Lakes Ave. Traffic Signal

Schedule: Nov. to Dec. 2017 Investment: \$200,000 Installation of a traffic signal at Worthington Road and Highland Lakes Avenue. Traffic maintained with short term lane restrictions.

2018+ ROAD & BRIDGE PROJECTS

A. Countywide Pavement Resurfacing (not mapped)

Schedule: Summer 2018 Investment: \$7 million Asphalt resurfacing, micro-surfacing, chip sealing, crack sealing, berm repair, pavement marking and other work on various county and township roads. Traffic maintained.

B. Centerburg Road over Culver Creek

Schedule: Summer 2018 Investment: \$280,000 Design-build rehabilitation of bridge just south of Fredricks Road. 2-month closure.

C. Bainbridge Mills Drive Relocation at Sawmill Pkwy.

Schedule: Summer 2018 Investment: \$600,000 Relocate Bainbridge Mills Drive at Sawmill Parkway to connect to Old Sawmill Road. 2-month closure of Bainbridge Mills Drive.

D. Home Road & State Route 315 Intersection

Schedule: Summer 2018 to 2019 Investment: \$7 million Widening of Home Road to 5 lanes, widening of the bridge over the Olentangy River, construction of a bike path and installation of a new traffic signal.

E. Home Road & Scioto Chase/Tree Lake Blvd. Traffic Signal

Schedule: Summer 2018 Investment: \$200,000 Installation of a traffic signal at Home Road & Scioto Chase/Tree Lake Blvd.

F. Piatt Road Extension (Cheshire to Berlin Station)

Schedule: Fall 2018 to 2019 Investment: \$3 million New roadway from Cheshire Road to Berlin Station Road serving Olentangy Berlin High School, and construction of a single-lane modern roundabout at the intersection of Cheshire Road and Piatt Road. 2-month closure of Cheshire Road.

G. Lewis Center & North Road Improvements

Schedule: Fall 2018 to 2019 Investment: \$3 million Widening of Lewis Center Rd. from the Olentangy High School entrance to the CSX Railroad including a single-lane modern roundabout at North Road. Also minor widening of North Road. approximately 1/2 mile north of Lewis Center with bike path.

H. East Powell Road Improvements, Phase 2

Schedule: 2019-20 Investment: \$8 million Widening of East Powell Rd. to 3 lanes from Old State to Bale Kenyon Road with new traffic signals at Tahoma Street, Coldharbor Ave. and Walker Wood Blvd.

I. Worthington Road Improvements, Phase 2

Schedule: 2019-20 Investment: \$7 million Widening of Worthington Road to 5 lanes at Africa Road, and adding a right turn lane on Africa Road. Worthington Road to transition to 3 lanes north of Africa Road to Highland Lakes Ave.
