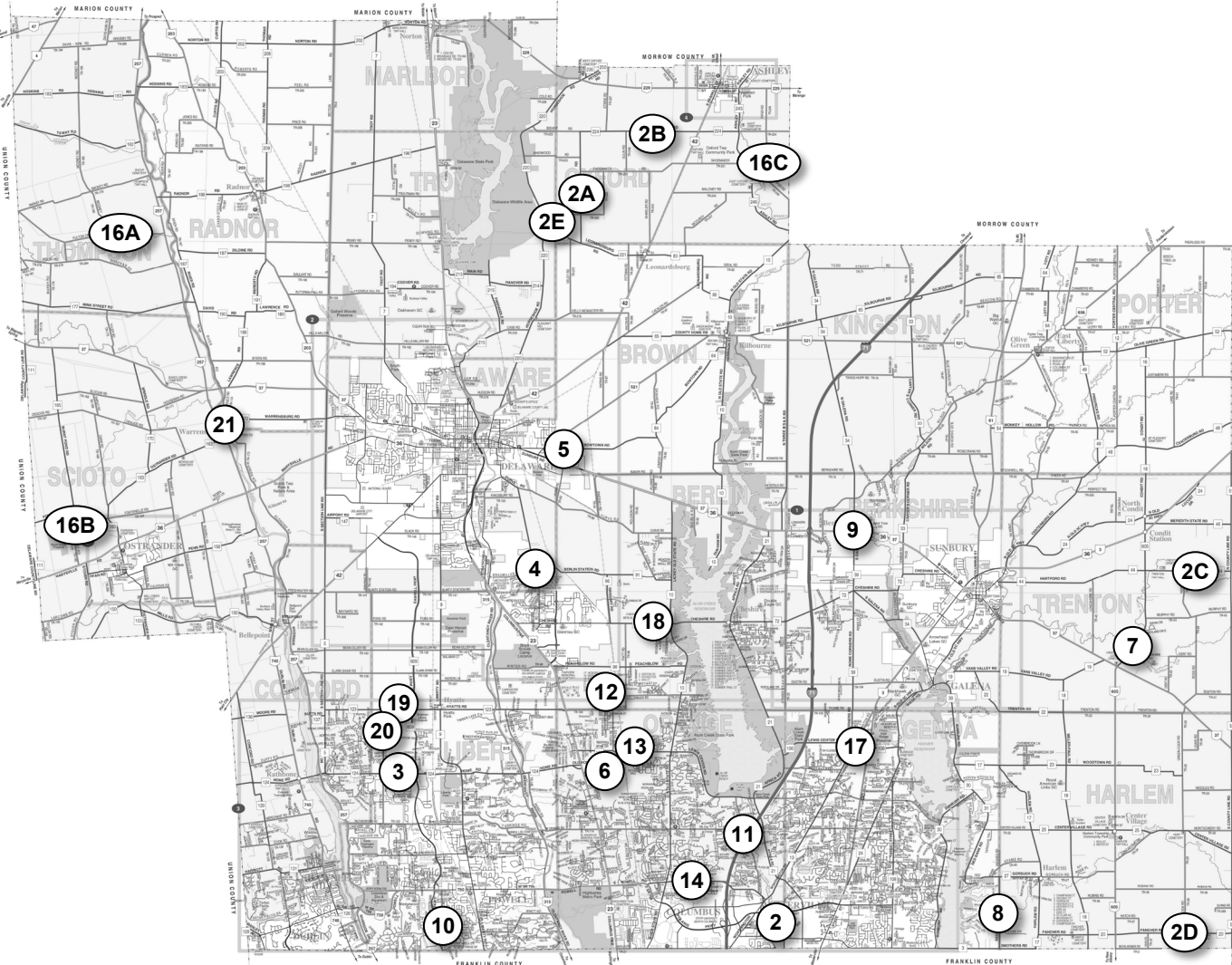

Did You Know...

The state motor fuel tax (38.5 cents per gallon for gasoline and 46 cents for diesel) and the charges you pay to register your vehicle are two of the main sources of road construction and maintenance funding in Ohio. These charges are in proportion to the size and weight of your vehicle and how much you drive. Trucks pay more in fuel tax and registration fees because they take up more space on the roads and are heavier than passenger vehicles so they cause more wear and tear on pavements.

- 1** **2023 Countywide Pavement Resurfacing**
May to October 2023 **Countywide**
\$3.5M Delaware County Road & Bridge Funds
\$4M Township Funds; \$1M OPWC Grants to Various Twps.
Asphalt resurfacing, micro-surfacing, chip sealing, crack sealing, berm repair, pavement marking and other work on various county and township roads throughout Delaware County. See the *2023 Paving Guide*.
- 2** **Small Bridge Replacement Projects**
April to November 2023 **Various Locations**
\$500K Delaware County Road & Bridge Funds
\$250K Federal Local Bridge Program
Replacement of small bridges at the following locations. 2± month closures for each bridge.
A. Steamtown Road 1 mile north of Leonardsburg Road
B. Steamtown Road west of US 42
C. Hartford Road just east of Ross Road
D. Green Cook Road 0.2 miles north of Franklin County Line
E. Whipple Road east of Horseshoe Road
- 3** **Home Road Recreational Trail**
August to October 2023 **Liberty Township**
\$200K State Capital Funding, \$100K Liberty Twp, \$11.25K Powell, \$60K Preservation Parks, \$22.5K Delaware County Trail Assistance
10-foot wide path along the north side of Home Road extending from Beautiful Savior Lutheran Church to Olentangy Liberty HS.
- 4** **Berlin Station and Braumiller Intersection**
June to September 2023 **Delaware Township**
\$2M Delaware County Road & Bridge Funds
Replacement of a large concrete culvert south of the intersection including road profile adjustment approaching the intersection. Minor shoulder widening on Berlin Station east to Glenn Parkway. 6-8 week closure of Braumiller Road south of Berlin Station.
- 5** **Byxbe Parkway, Phase 1B**
September 2023 to June 2024 **Delaware & Brown Twp**
\$4.5M Delaware County Road & Bridge Funds
Construction of a new 4-lane roadway from U.S. 36 at Glenn Road extending north to Bowtown Road. Lane restrictions on US 36 for intersection work.
- 6** **Green Meadows Drive (Home to Lewis Center)**
July 2023 to June 2024 **Orange Township**
\$1.2M Development Assessment
\$700K Delaware County Road & Bridge Funds
\$500K Ohio Public Works Funds
Construction of a 0.9 mile long, 3-lane road connecting the Lewis Center and North Road roundabout to the new Home Road Extension east of US 23. No traffic impacts during construction.
- 7** **CR 605 Shoulder Paving and Resurfacing**
June to September 2023 **Trenton Township**
\$1.0M Federal Highway Safety Funds
\$100K Delaware County Road & Bridge Funds
Shoulder paving and resurfacing on CR 605 from SR 37 to Murphy Road. One lane, two-way traffic maintained with flaggers.
- 8** **Red Bank Road Shoulder Paving and Resurfacing**
June to October 2023 **Genoa/Harlem Township**
\$600K Federal Surface Transportation Block Grant Funds
\$400K Delaware County Road & Bridge Funds
Shoulder paving and resurfacing on Red Bank Road from Smothers to Gorsuch Road. One lane, two-way traffic maintained with flaggers.
- 9** **US36 / SR 37 and Galena Road**
June to October 2023 **Berkshire Township**
\$2M Federal Highway Safety Funds
\$1M Delaware County Road & Bridge Funds
Construction of left and right turn lanes on each intersection approach, along with a new traffic signal. Traffic will be maintained on US 36/SR 37. Short-term closures on Galena Road. Joint project with ODOT.
- 10** **Old Sawmill Road and Presidential Parkway**
July to October 2023 **Powell & Liberty Twp.**
\$550K Federal Highway Safety Funds; \$500K OPWC
\$300K Delaware County Road & Bridge Funds
\$150K Liberty Township and \$50K Powell
Construction of a modern roundabout at Old Sawmill Road and Presidential Parkway, including resurfacing of Presidential Parkway west to Sawmill Parkway. Full intersection closure for about 8 weeks.
- 11** **Bale Kenyon Road Improvements, Phase 1**
July to November 2023 **Orange Township**
\$2.7M Orange Twp, \$500K OPWC; \$500K Delaware County TID
Widening and reconstruction of Bale Kenyon Road beginning at Orange Road and extending south for about 1/2 mile including new curbs, gutters, a shared use path and drainage improvements. Full closure to through traffic for about 3 months with traffic maintained to residences in the work zone.
- 12** **Home Road Extension at Lewis Center Road**
Fall 2023 to Summer 2024 **Orange Township**
\$2.5M Delaware County Road & Bridge Funds
Construction of a modern roundabout on Lewis Center Road at the intersection of the new Home Road Extension, located about 500 feet east of Fifth Street in the village of Lewis Center. Traffic will be maintained on Lewis Center Road with a temporary road around the north side of the new roundabout, with short-term closures for tie-ins.
- 13** **North Road, Phase 2 (Shanahan to Shale Meadows)**
Fall/Winter 2023 to Summer 2024 **Berlin Township**
\$3M Developer Funds
\$1.5M Delaware County Road & Bridge Funds
Construction of 1 mile of new 3-lane road extending north from Shanahan Road to the already completed section at Shale Meadows Elementary School. Minimal impact to traffic on Shanahan Road.
- 14** **East Powell Road Shared Use Path and Sidewalks**
Fall/Winter 2023 to Summer 2024 **Orange Township**
\$500K Delaware County Funds; \$250K Orange Township;
\$150K Federal Recreational Trail Funds
Construction of a 10-foot wide shared use path on the north side and completion of a 5-foot wide sidewalk on the south side of East Powell Road from Old State Road to Lyra Drive. Minimal traffic disruption.
- 15** **2024 Countywide Pavement Resurfacing**
Summer/Fall 2024 **Countywide**
\$3.6 M Delaware County Road & Bridge Funds
\$4M Township Funds; \$1M OPWC Grants to Various Twps.
Asphalt resurfacing, micro-surfacing, chip sealing, crack sealing, berm repair, pavement marking and other work on various county and township roads.
- 16** **Small Bridge Replacement Projects**
Summer 2024 to Fall 2025 **Various Locations**
\$500K to \$1.5M Federal Local Bridge Program
\$200K to \$2M Delaware County Road & Bridge Funds
Replacement of small bridges at the following locations. Road closures of 4-6 months for each bridge.
A. Fulton Creek Road over Fulton Creek, 0.1 mi. east of Mooney Rd.
B. Burnt Pond Road over Bokes Creek, 0.1 mi. south of Fontanelle Rd.
C. Steamtown Road over Alum Creek, 0.1 mi. east of Ashley Rd.
- 17** **Worthington and Lewis Center Road**
Spring/Summer 2024 **Genoa Township**
\$1.5M Federal Highway Safety Funds
Construction of a peanut-shaped roundabout at Worthington and Lewis Center Road. 8-10 week intersection closure with access maintained for residences in the work zone.
- 18** **Cheshire Road (Piatt to Old State)**
Spring/Summer 2024 **Berlin Township**
\$2.5M Delaware County Road & Bridge Funds
Widening Cheshire Road to a 3-lane section between the 2 roundabouts at Piatt Road (west) and Old State Road (east). One-way traffic maintained for about 3 months.
- 19** **Hyatts Road Widening (Steitz Road to Sawmill Pkwy.)**
Spring/Summer 2024 **Liberty Township**
\$1.7M Delaware County Road & Bridge Funds
Widening Hyatts Road to a 3-lane section between the 2 roundabouts at Steitz Road (west) and Sawmill Pkwy. (east). One-way traffic maintained for about 3 months.
- 20** **Steitz Road Widening (Liberty Grand Blvd. to Hyatts Road)**
Summer/Fall 2024 **Liberty Township**
\$2M Delaware County Road & Bridge Funds
\$720K Developer Contributions
Pavement and shoulder widening, safety and drainage improvements on Steitz Road from Harvest Point to Hyatts Road. Full closure for approximately 4 months. Two-way access to Harvest Point and Liberty Grand maintained from Home Road.
- 21** **Warrensburg Road over Scioto River**
Summer/Fall 2024 **Scioto Township**
\$665K Federal Local Bridge Program
\$35K Delaware County Road & Bridge Funds
Rehabilitation of the existing pony-truss on Warrensburg Road just east of SR 257 including replacement of the floor system and repair of the truss. Bridge will be closed for 3-4 months.
